Note:

If you want to visit Auschwitz you need to be in Cracow by Thursday morning (9am), which means you will have to fly out of London on Wednesday evening.

*Depending on how many people are interested in this option the total additional cost of guided tour, transfer and accommodation on Wednesday night should be around **£60** per person.*

FAQ

How do I get there?

Look for flights to Krakow (Cracow), mainly operated by Ryanair and Wizzair. You can also look for flights to Katowice, which is around 1.5h drive away from Krakow. If you want to visit Auschwitz you need to fly on Wednesday night.

How do I get back?

Look for flights from Warsaw on Sunday afternoon (operated by Ryanair, Wizzair, LOT, BA)

Where will we be staying?

We will be staying in shared apartments and hostels.
Be prepared to share accommodation with others.
