

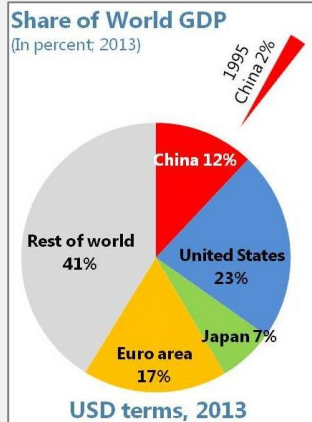
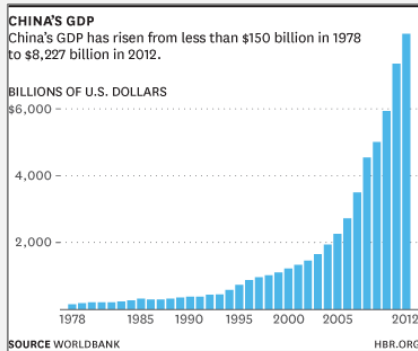
2017 China Cultural Trek

Where are we going, and are we doing?

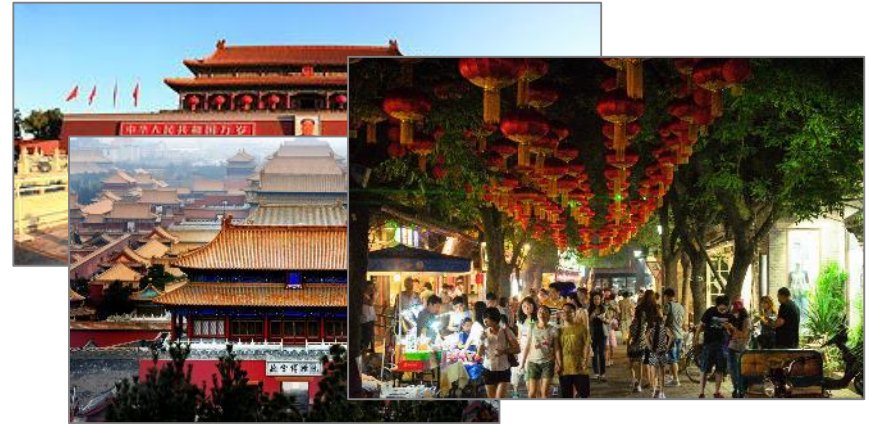

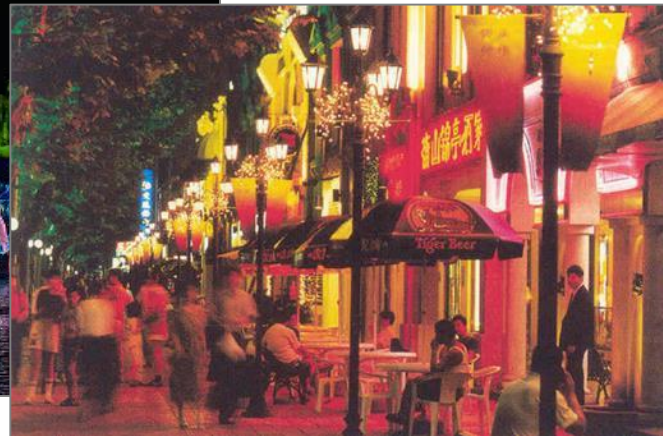

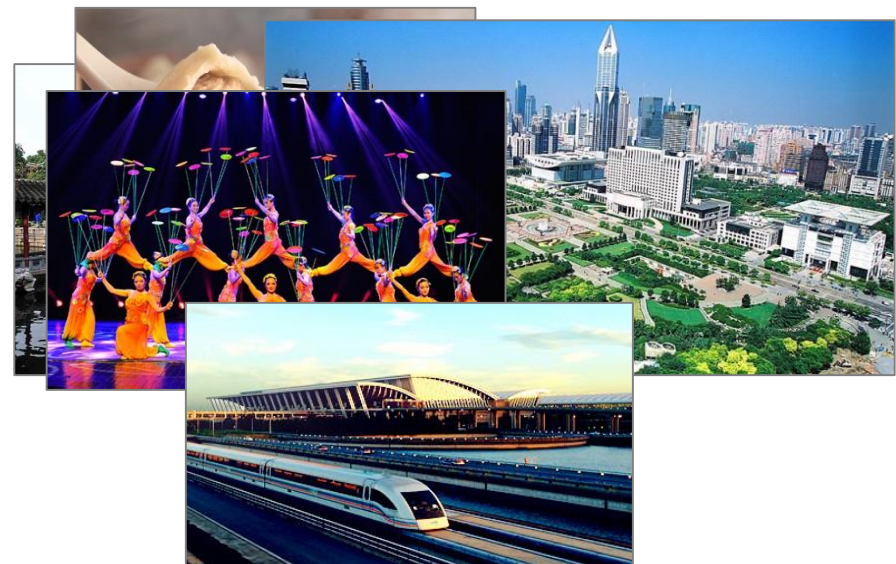

Purchase a Ticket

- Tickets will go on sale **Dec 4 (Sun) at 12:00 pm**
 - Tickets will be available until Jan 4, 2017 (or until sold out)
- There will be **40** tickets available
- Ticket cost: **£598** (does not include airfare or optional events)
- Full payment must be provided at time of ticket sale

Book Your Flight

- Arrive in Beijing by 11:00 am on March 21 (Tues)
 - Please let us know if you cannot arrive on time. We will do our best to accommodate, but note that you will likely miss out on some events
- Depart Shanghai on March 26 (Sun)
 - Those people going on the Asian treks can fly from Shanghai straight to the next destination

Apply for a Visa

- Those who need a visa should apply at least one month prior to the trek (the earlier the better!)
- The trek team will provide support in your applications

Notes on Accommodation

- All accommodation is provided in the cost of the ticket!
- We will be staying exclusively in 4-5 star hotels (rates have been negotiated by the trek team)
- We will release housing surveys in early 2017 for room preferences
