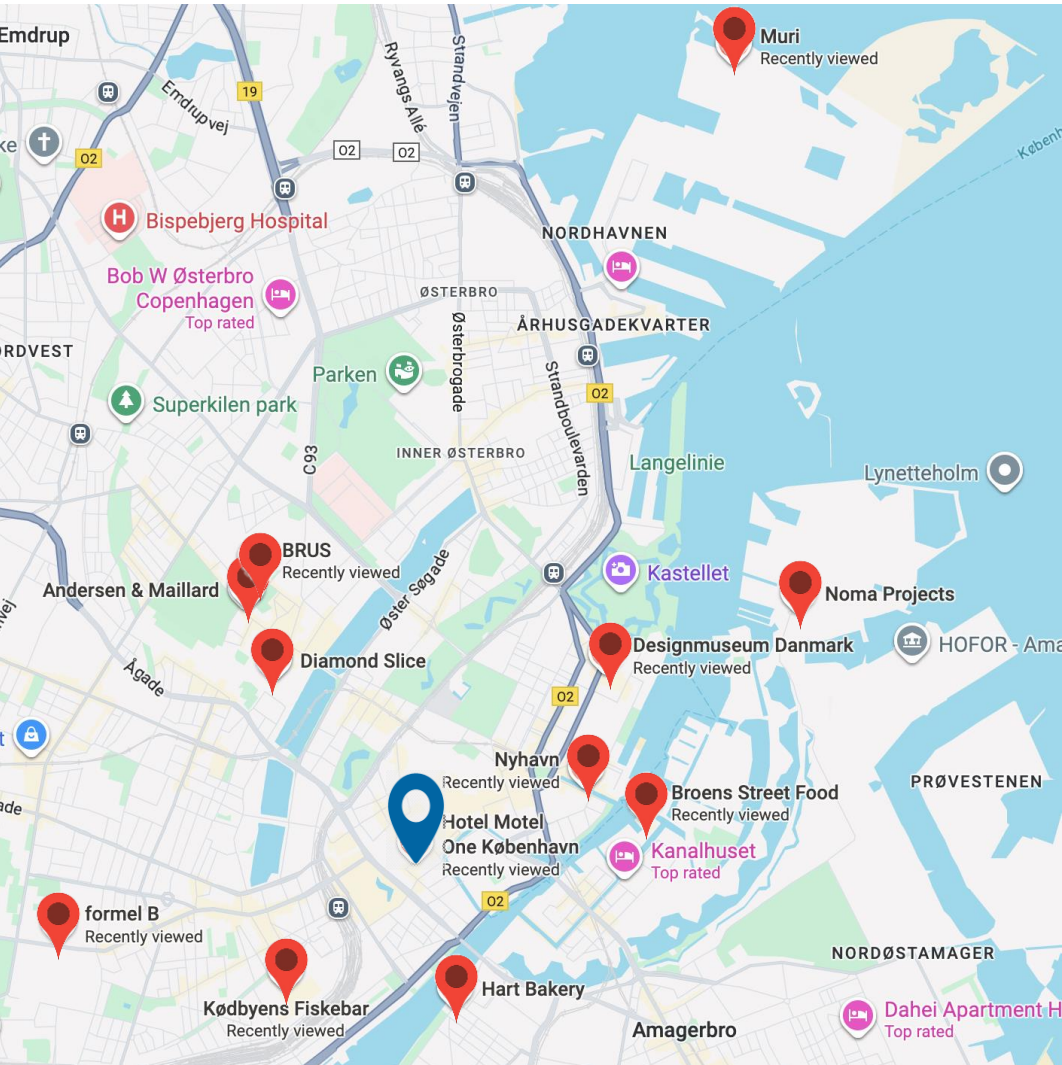
Sunday
