Which flights should I book?

- There are mainly two options to go to Kyoto from London
 - Direct Flight to Osaka and use local take train to Kyoto
 - Direct Flight to Tokyo and use local train and bullet train to Kyoto
 - There are other cheaper non-direct flights, please refer

- From OSAKA (ITAMI) Int'l Airpor
- To KYOTO Station Hachijoguchi Exit: Approx. 55 min by Airport Limousine Bus
- From KANSAI Int'l Airport
- To KYOTO Station Hachijoguchi Exit: Approx. 88 min by Airport Limousine Bus To KYOTO Station: 75 min by JR Kansai International Airport EXPRESS Haruka
- By Train
- From KYOTO Station Hachijoguchi Exit served by JR/Shinkansen/KINTETSU Lines: 2 min walk
- From Subway KYOTO Station: 5 min walk

- For countries without exemption, VISA applications (excluding "Certificate of Eligibility" applications) must be submitted at least 1 week before departure.
- *We strongly recommend that you start the process <u>at least one</u> month before departure. (This is your responsibility)
